STRATEGY SUMMARY AND GUIDELINES

Fort Washington's Dividend Equity Strategy uses a unique approach, resulting in a portfolio of high-quality companies with sustainable competitive advantages that should pay reliable, growing dividends at reasonable valuations.

Supported by theory and evidence, the strategy focuses on fourth quintile dividend yielding stocks and employs fundamental input from a deeply experienced equity research team. The result is a portfolio of above-average dividend paying stocks that enjoy competitive advantages and will grow dividends over time but avoids highest tall limits portfolio tracking error versus the broad market. A disciplined and repeatable process allows for a cost-efficient portfolio with favorable risk and reward characteristics. All fee-paying, fully discretionary portfolios managed in the Dividend Equity style, with a minimum of \$3 million under our management, are included in this composite. The strategy's fee schedule is 0.50% and the first \$25 million and 0.30% on additional amounts over \$25 million for separate accounts. Portfolios in this composite include cash, cash equivalents, investment advisory fees and other expenses that may be incurred in the management fees and include the reinvestments of the described on o
